SAFETY RULES (must read & sign to play)

1. Minimum age allowed to participate is 12 years old. Ages 12-17 can play with the signed consent of their parent or legal guardian.
2. Always wear approved paintball goggles when using a paintball marker or when near an active discharging/shooting area. Not adhering to this rule is cause for immediate dismissal from the game. In goggle required areas the goggle/mask may not be removed for any reason which includes: fogging, painted lenses or during an injury.
3. A barrel cover/sleeve must be used when not shooting or when you are not in an active field of play. We do not accept barrel plugs.
4. All paintball markers must be chronographed prior to use in play and shall not exceed a velocity of 280 feet per second.
5. Never shoot at anyone who is not wearing approved eye protection or anyone whose safety gear is not in place.
6. A player is not allowed to shoot at any other player showing a neutrality symbol, any non-player, or object, outside the perimeter of the active playing field or shooting range. Vandalism, endangerment and mischief are crimes. Knowingly shooting towards a person you know has no safety equipment will make you liable for injury sustained and criminal negligence.
7. Never point, cock or load the paintball marker while it's pointed in the direction of any person.
8. No physical confrontation between players, referees or customers. Any violation will result in immediate dismissal from the park and notification to police.
9. Consumption of alcohol or drugs on the premises or in the parking area is prohibited.
10. Never look down the barrel of a marker. Even if there are no paintballs in your marker (which should not be assumed) there may be shell fragments, dirt, sand or other loose materials that can cause damage. No Dry Firing.
11. Paintball markers with approved barrel cover must be carried in a safe manner with the barrel pointing to the ground while in the staging, neutral, or parking areas. No waving marker around in a neutral area.
12. No discharging or dry firing of paintball marker is allowed in any neutral or non playing area.
13. Do not use a paintball marker until you have been versed on its use and understand such use.
14. Do not shoot across neutral, staging or parking lot area.
15. You can not play or use target range without signing Waiver / Release Form #1 and Safety Rules Form # 2.

WE MAINTAIN THE RIGHT TO REFUSE PARTICIPATION TO ANYONE ON ANY GROUNDS DEEMED APPLICABLE BY US. THERE ARE NO REFUNDS ON FIELD FEES OR PAINTBALLS IF YOU ARE ASKED TO LEAVE BECAUSE OF RULE VIOLATIONS.

- **You Must be 12 years or older to Play.**
- **Your Driver's License and a Credit Card are required and will be safely kept for all equipment rentals at Registration.**
- **No ID Card? Then a parent, guardian, or individual 18 years or older with a Driver's License and Credit Card must accept responsibility for your equipment's return and condition.**
- **Individuals can also have more than one set of equipment rentals secured in their name.**
- **Your Driver's License and Credit Card will be returned to you at the Registration office when the equipment is returned in good condition. You will be charged our Pro Shop Retail Fee for any lost or damaged equipment.**
- **Rental Package (\$40) includes: Field fee, Air fee, Tippman 98 Custom marker, Barrel cover, Nitro air tank, V Force thermo shield goggles, NXE Harness with 2 pods, Neck guard.**
- **You will have to give your equipment rental receipt to the Rental Staff when you pick up your equipment at the Paint/Equipment Rental Area.**
- **Rental Equipment is on a first come basis. To ensure availability rental equipment can be reserved with a \$20 per rental non refundable deposit.**
